*Important Information about Criminal Background Checks, Liability Insurance Forms and Personal Affirmation Forms:*

A criminal background check (CBC) is good for two years. Students who apply need a background check that is no more than two years old. If you need a new background check, go to [certifiedbackground.com](http://certifiedbackground.com) to complete the process. A current Insurance Liability Form (ILF) and Personal Affirmation Form (PAF) are also required.

If completing a new CBC, you will complete the Insurance Liability Form and Personal Affirmation Form as part of the CBC process. Print out the forms, fill them out, sign them, and then upload them to the [certifiedbackground.com](http://certifiedbackground.com) website. (Many students who have taken EDUC 2110 or 2120 recently have already done this. Just make sure your information is up-to-date.)

If your existing CBC will still be good for HIST 3271, please complete the ILF and PAF in hard copy (available on the CEPP placement request website) and upload them to the [certifiedbackground.com](http://certifiedbackground.com) website.

\*HIST 3271 will only be taught in the fall semester and HIST 4488 will only be taught in the spring semester. A 30-hour field experience at a local middle school is part of both classes.
